

Good morning All.

We had a visit from the local fire house on Wednesday and we discussed with them the shutdown of the building, they mentioned that they would keep an eye on the building whilst the work was going on.

We have also contacted the Sheriff's dept. and made them aware of the shut down and ongoing work, they will do extra visits that week to ensure the building is safe. During the shutdown we will have Shawn on site and the electrical crews, from approximately 6.30 am – 5 pm.

This morning, we had a visit from the Pasco County Fire Marshall, he spoke with Anita and myself and we have some news.

IF YOU INTEND TO REMAIN IN THE BUILDING AGAINST OUR ADVICE WHILST THE SHUT DOWN IS TAKING PLACE, PLEASE DO NOT EXPECT THE FIRE DEPT. TO COME AND HELP YOU EITHER DOWN OR UP THE STAIRS,

ALSO, ANYONE REMAINING IN THE BUILDING MUST TAKE ON "FIRE WATCH".

This means patrolling the building at 60-minute intervals, all floors and completing a log to say that it is done. This must be done throughout the day and night, once an hour, (24/7). The log will become part of the official records of Sea Castle Condominiums.

It is also recommended that no work or remodeling be scheduled that week, contractors will not have access to the elevators, they will have no power for tools. It will be more of a hazard than a convenience for you and them.
